<u>Status of camera/internet connection</u> - Ben reported that the internet cable was severed and has been replaced; the security cameras are now functioning. It was requested to have Cypress Access now test the connection to the gate fob system.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

<u>Vandalism</u> - With the restored cameras we were able to access the footage from children vandalizing the pool bathroom. Punitive actions were discussed. It was requested to obtain a quote to install an additional camera facing the parking lot.

<u>Resurfacing of courts</u> - It was requested that all previously obtained quotes be updated for more accurate pricing.

<u>Grass condition at the dock park</u> - It is currently in poor condition. It was requested to have Hector check if irrigation is in that area.

<u>Homeowner violations</u> - A new method for inspecting the parcels will commence next week.
