OLD BUSINESS:

- a. <u>Landscape/park project status</u> Juliana Barnes furnished a presentation containing preliminary costs on all aspects of the renovation project. - e. <u>Electronic voting update</u> Danielle only received about 20 responses to the electronic voting discussion. Juliana Barnes offered to assist Danielle in reaching other platforms in hopes to increase participation.
