- a. <u>Landscape/park project status</u> Ben stated that the landscape architect is currently in the process of finalizing the drawings to reflect changes discussed at the previous meeting. Upon completion, they will be ready to distribute to vendors for a formal proposal.
- b. <u>Security cameras</u> Bill met with Victor who installed the new cameras at the pool who said that where they are currently placed, they will not be able to get a full view of the entry gate.

A motion was made to install an additional camera to position toward the entry gate to the pool and to expend up to \$400.

- e. <u>Miscellaneous</u> There was an issue that was brought up regarding a new regulation on school pickup parking. It was requested that CCSO be invited to join a meeting with the board and/or membership to discuss the County Ordinance that parents have been told they are in violation of and come up with alternative options.
